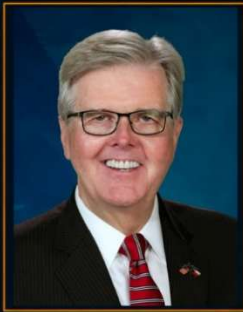

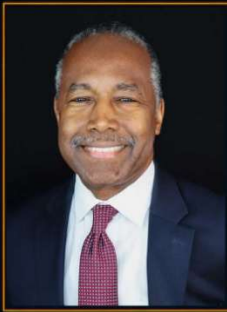

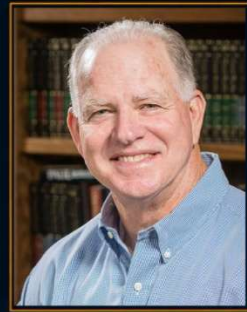

Training



Why are we doing this? In 2018 we were noted as the largest voting Republican block with a 98% to 2%, i.e. Republican to Democrat voter edge. In 2024 it decreased. You saw it when I ran for school board. Had Robson Ranch showed up, I might have been on the school board and we might not have voted in-at least so strongly-a \$26 million dollar bond. At least, I would have squawked to all of you!

Now, going into 2026 and looking to 2028 we are showing a 55% Republican to 45% Democrat. That ought to wake you up. That ought to make you concerned. That ought to propel you to the polls during election time. That ought to make you be informed and not put your head in the sands, and say, "I am so sick of politics. It is always corrupt, or it is always icky, or it is just bad news." The ONLY way to turn it around, is to VOTE IT OUT!

You have a voice. We are asking you to use it, to your friends. This app connects on your phone to your contacts. It is confidential. It does not share your contacts or your personal data with anyone. When the app sends a phone number....it does not use your number, it uses a number for the Texas Republican Party. It is easy to use and David will show us and help us navigate the site. It is not hard! I wish we did not have to work so hard to get folks to the polls, but apparently, we do. This tool will help us with this strategy.

- Android (Samsung, Google, etc.): Download from the Google Play Store → Open Google Play and search “Abbott Impact”

Republican Candidates on Your November Ballot

As you prepare for the upcoming election, the Robson Ranch Republican Club is pleased to provide a clear, easy-to-use voter guide featuring all Republican candidates who will appear on your ballot. You will be receiving a pushcard in the September and October editions of the Pioneer Press. You are allowed to take these to the polls and use as a voter

guide. Several races this year are uncontested, they will be shown in yellow on the pushcard coming in the Pioneer Press, meaning these Republican nominees will move forward without opposition. The places with an * depict an uncontested race in our newsletter here. Your pushcard will not show the 18 uncontested races. Rather, vote for the Republican. It is VERY IMPORTANT that you vote all the way DOWN THE BALLOT. The LAST place on the ballot is being run by a Republican, and she is CONTESTED. Your vote for her, Crystal Levonious WILL MATTER!! Other races include contested seats where your vote will help determine the outcome.

I want to point out some very important races to Robson Residents. They are **Denton County Clerk-Juli Luke; Denton County Judge-Andy Eads; Denton County Commissioner Distr #4-David Wylie; County Justice of the Peace, Pct #4 Harris Hughey and 481st Judicial District Crt-Crystal Levonius**. These candidates ALL represent us here at Robson and they are being challenged by a democrat. It is extremely important WE VOTE FOR THEM!!

I also want to encourage you to fill in your ballot all the way down. Even when a candidate is NOT contested, you SHOULD fill in the dot. We must leave NO ROOM for counter argument when not enough votes are drawn. While the election code notes we do not NEED to fill in the dot, it is ENCOURAGED you fill it in.

This guide is designed to help you quickly identify each office and the Republican candidate running for it, so you can head to the polls with confidence and clarity. Keep this pushcard handy when you vote—whether during early voting or on Election Day—and share it with neighbors who may find it helpful.

Your participation matters. Thank you for staying informed, engaged, and committed to supporting strong Republican leadership at every level of government.

Your 2026 Republican Voter Guide

Robson Ranch voters in Precincts 4185 and 4186 will see 44 Republican candidates on the November ballot, spanning federal, state, judicial, and local offices. This voter guide provides a simple, at-a-glance reference to every Republican candidate, along with their campaign website when available. Several races are uncontested this year, and those will appear in yellow on the pushcard for quick identification.

Use this guide during **Early Voting, October 19–30**, or on **Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 7 a.m.–7 p.m.**, to help you navigate the ballot with confidence. Keep the pushcard handy, share it with neighbors, and stay engaged as we prepare for an important midterm election.
